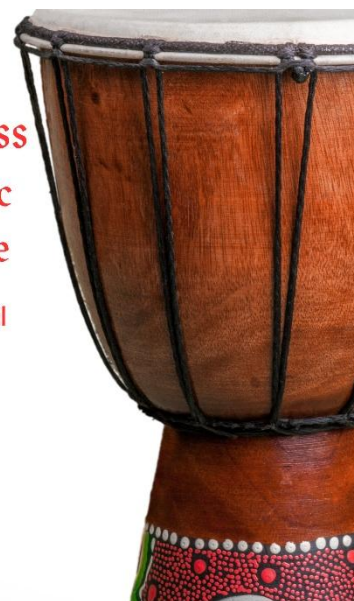
EASTER SERVICE

YEAR 4 MTC

Year 4 pupils will have their Multiplication Tables Check in June. The purpose of the check is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently up to 12 x 12. This fundamental skill is essential for your child's future success in mathematics as they move into year 5 and beyond.

The check consists of 25 times questions, of which the children will have six seconds to read, solve and type their answer. To help your child feel confident and prepared, we ask that they practise their multiplication facts as regularly as possible at home. Short, frequent bursts of practise are often more effective than long sessions.

We highly recommend Times Table Rock Stars (TTRockstars). This is a fantastic tool that mimics the format of the check and helps build the speed and accuracy required. Your child's log in details can be found in the front of their reading diaries.
